

HIGHER AMBITION REQUIRES BETTER CLIMATE PLANNING

THE 'EFFORT SHARING' REGULATION CAN ONLY BE A SUCCESS
IF IT STRENGTHENS NATIONAL CLIMATE PLANNING AND
NATIONAL OWNERSHIP



REQUIRE MEMBER STATES TO ADOPT CLIMATE NEUTRALITY TARGETS

MEMBER STATES SHOULD ADOPT A NATIONAL CLIMATE-
NEUTRALITY TARGET AND SET OUT HOW THEY PLAN TO
ACHIEVE THIS TARGET IN REVAMPED AND REGULARLY
UPDATED NATIONAL LONG-TERM STRATEGIES (NLTS).

THE EU SHOULD LEAD BY EXAMPLE AND ROUTINELY UPDATE ITS LONG-TERM STRATEGY

IN LINE WITH THE GLASGOW CLIMATE PACT, THE EU
SHOULD ENSURE ITS' LONG-TERM STRATEGY IS UP TO
DATE AND THAT IT IDENTIFIES EU-WIDE ECONOMIC
SECTORS' DECARBONISATION PATHWAYS.



EXISTING RULES ON NATIONAL PLANS MUST BE STRENGTHENED

MEMBER STATES MUST DESCRIBE HOW THEIR
PLANNED MEASURES WILL ACHIEVE INCREASED ESR
TARGETS AND SPECIFY THEIR EMISSIONS
REDUCTION OBJECTIVES FOR EACH SECTOR.

SHOW THE MONEY FOR CLIMATE ACTION IN NATIONAL PLANS

EFFECTIVE CLIMATE ACTION REQUIRES THE
MOBILISATION OF INVESTMENT. NATIONAL PLANS
MUST SET OUT MEMBER STATES' INVESTMENT NEEDS
AND SOURCES FOR EACH ECONOMIC SECTOR.



HIGHER AMBITION REQUIRES PUBLIC TRUST AND PARTICIPATION IN CLIMATE PLANNING

THE PUBLIC MUST HAVE RIGHTS TO MEANINGFUL PARTICIPATION AND BE ABLE TO UPHOLD
THOSE RIGHTS BEFORE THEIR NATIONAL COURTS.

THE PUBLIC CAN ONLY PARTICIPATE IF THEY HAVE ACCESS TO ACCURATE INFORMATION ABOUT
THE REAL POLICY OPTIONS. THE EU SHOULD ADOPT GUIDELINES TO HELP COUNTRIES TAKE UP
THE EU CLIMATE LAW INVITATION TO ESTABLISH NATIONAL CLIMATE ADVISORY BODIES.
